### Level 1

- Complete “Involving Southern Baptists in Disaster Relief”
- Complete “Southern Baptist Disaster Relief Basic Course

### Level 2

- Complete one unit of training in either Critical Incident Stress Management **CISM** (about 16 hrs) or National Organization for Victim Assistance **NOVA** (about 40 hrs)
