Training Overview

This training is open to:

1. New Volunteers
2. Current Volunteers updating their training which is required every 3 years.

Although this training is open to participants of all ages, only those persons age 18 years or

older and an active member of a BCM/D church are eligible to serve with the BCM/D teams on disaster responses.

TRAINING CLASSES OFFERED AT CONFERENCE

Introduction to Disaster Relief

Required for all NEW volunteers

This is the prerequisite course to all unit training and specialized classes.

New Volunteers must take the Intro Class and at least one "unit class" to receive their yellow hats.

Recovery Unit

This class will overview the three types of recovery work done by our Maryland/Delaware units: chainsaw, mud out, and temporary emergency repairs.

Feeding Unit

This class covers the equipment and operation of a mass-care feeding program. Emphasis is given to sanitation and health issues dealing with food preparation.

NOTE: Feeding unit class is made up of 2 parts. Part One (classroom) and Part Two (Hands on). In order to receive credit, volunteers must complete BOTH parts.

Elective Classes

Additional elective classes will be offered. Please check website for details.



Please Read:

Due to Homeland Security requirements, all disaster response organizations must now perform background security checks in order to receive new or updated ID badges. The necessary paperwork can be completed prior to the training event or at the door. Please note that we cannot issue ID badges until we received the results back from ChoicePoint—this normally takes 3-5 days.
