What to Bring

- Sports clothing (**no short-shorts or cut-off shirts; no tank tops or spaghetti straps**)
- Closed-in shoes **ONLY**; socks
- Jacket or sweater
- Bathing suit (one-piece or T-shirt over two piece)
- Beach robe or other beach cover-up
- Personal hygiene and grooming items
- Spending money (no more than \$30)
- Pillow and blanket/linens for bunk beds/sleeping bag
- Flip-flops for showers and pool **ONLY**
- Towels and wash cloths
- Rain gear
- Pencil/pen; 1 permanent marker
- Bible
- Flashlight
- Sunscreen; insect repellent
- Bring a dressier outfit (dress, skirt or slacks and nice top) to wear for the candle light service. **NO HEELS!** Sandals or flat shoes only.

Rules, Regulations and Directions

1. **Fees are not refundable on cancellations received later than two weeks before the start of camp.** Exceptions will be made in the event of illness or death in the family. Registrations may be transferred to other campers.
2. **No camper will be allowed to stay at camp unless all forms have been received.**
3. No camper will be admitted to camp before the specified time.
4. Due to BCM/D policies, no registrations can be accepted after the deadline.
5. **Cabin mate assignments will not be made during on-site registration. These requests need to be made on the registration form.**
6. No more than \$30 spending money per camper may be brought to camp.
7. Campers may not use camp phones. Cell phones are **NOT** to be brought to camp. Emergency calls will be placed by the camp director. Campers are not allowed to receive incoming calls, unless it is an emergency (this helps to eliminate homesickness.) The phone number for emergencies is 410-557-6296. This is the camp office phone and may switch over to the answering machine. Please leave a message as the voice mail is checked often.
8. Smoking is not allowed.
9. Cell phones, radios, CD/DVD players, beepers, comic books, food and gum may not be brought to camp.
10. Campers are not permitted to leave camp.
11. In the event campers must leave early, they must have a note signed by a parent/guardian. They must be sent in advance to the camp director or given to the camp director during on-site registration.
12. To ensure safety for your child, the enclosed form regarding pick up of your child must be brought to registration. The person or persons bringing the camper to camp must check camper into camp. All campers **MUST** checkout with their cabin leader before leaving camp.
13. **Upon request** articles which are left at camp will be mailed C.O.D. to the owner.

Girls Camp Registration Procedure

1. Registration begins at 3:00 pm in the Fellowship Hall, and dinner is served at 5:30 pm.

 - d. Health forms if not already mailed to the office. No one may remain at camp without these forms.
 - e. Any other forms requested and not mailed in.
