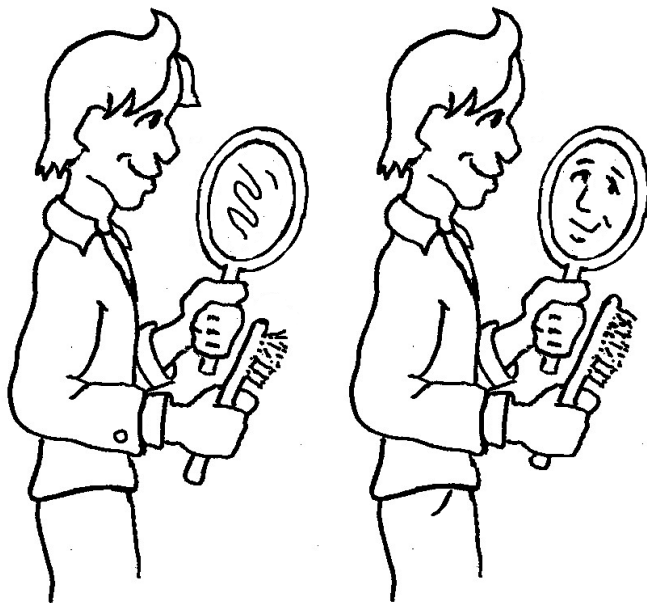


When it is Foolish to Listen

Circle the six differences between the two pictures.



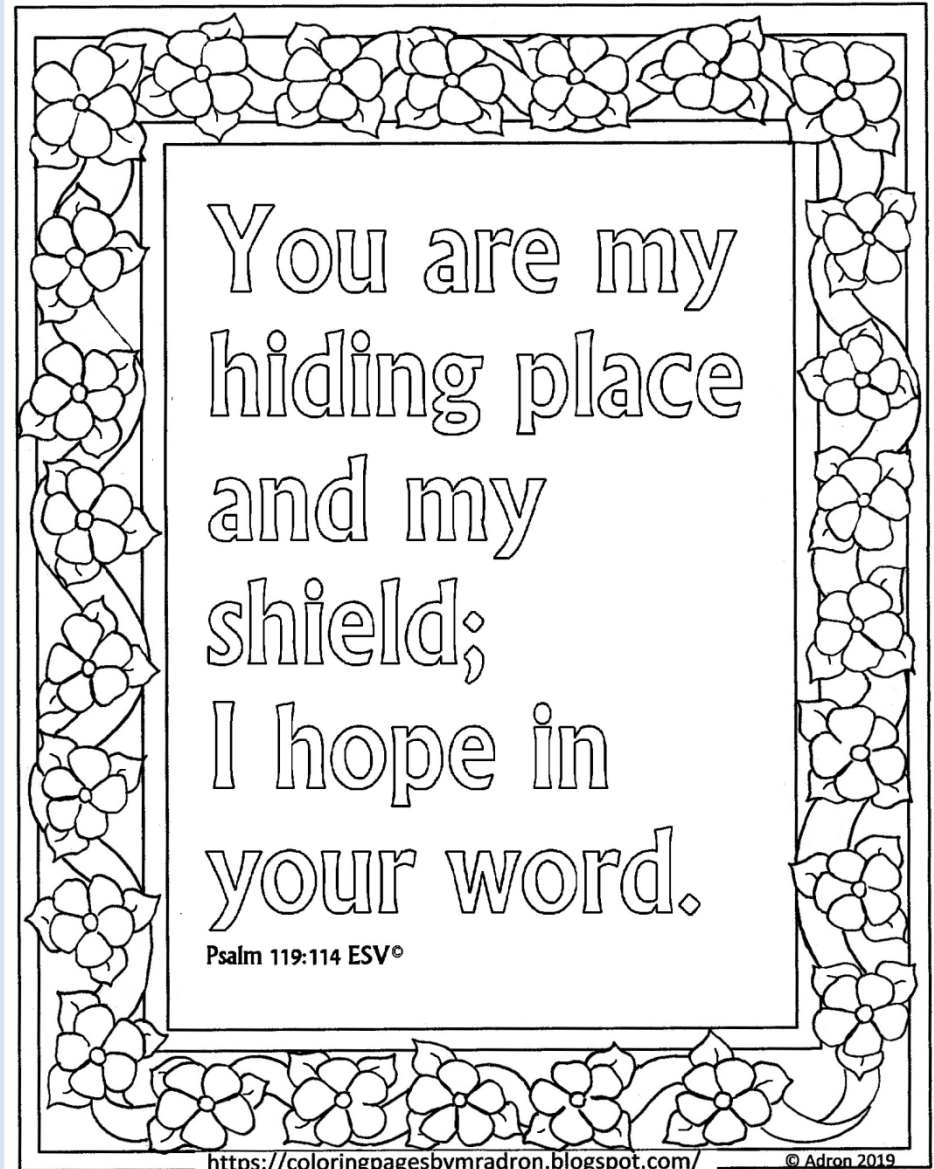

Show me your faith without deeds, and I will show you my faith by my deeds.

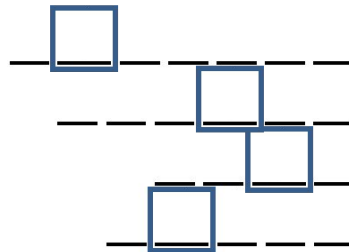
