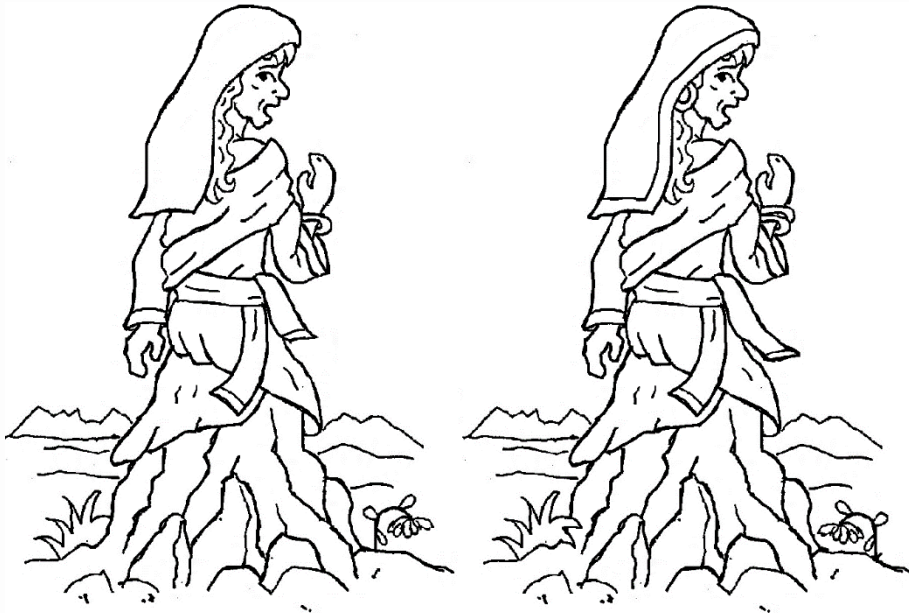


## Lot's Wife Disobeys God

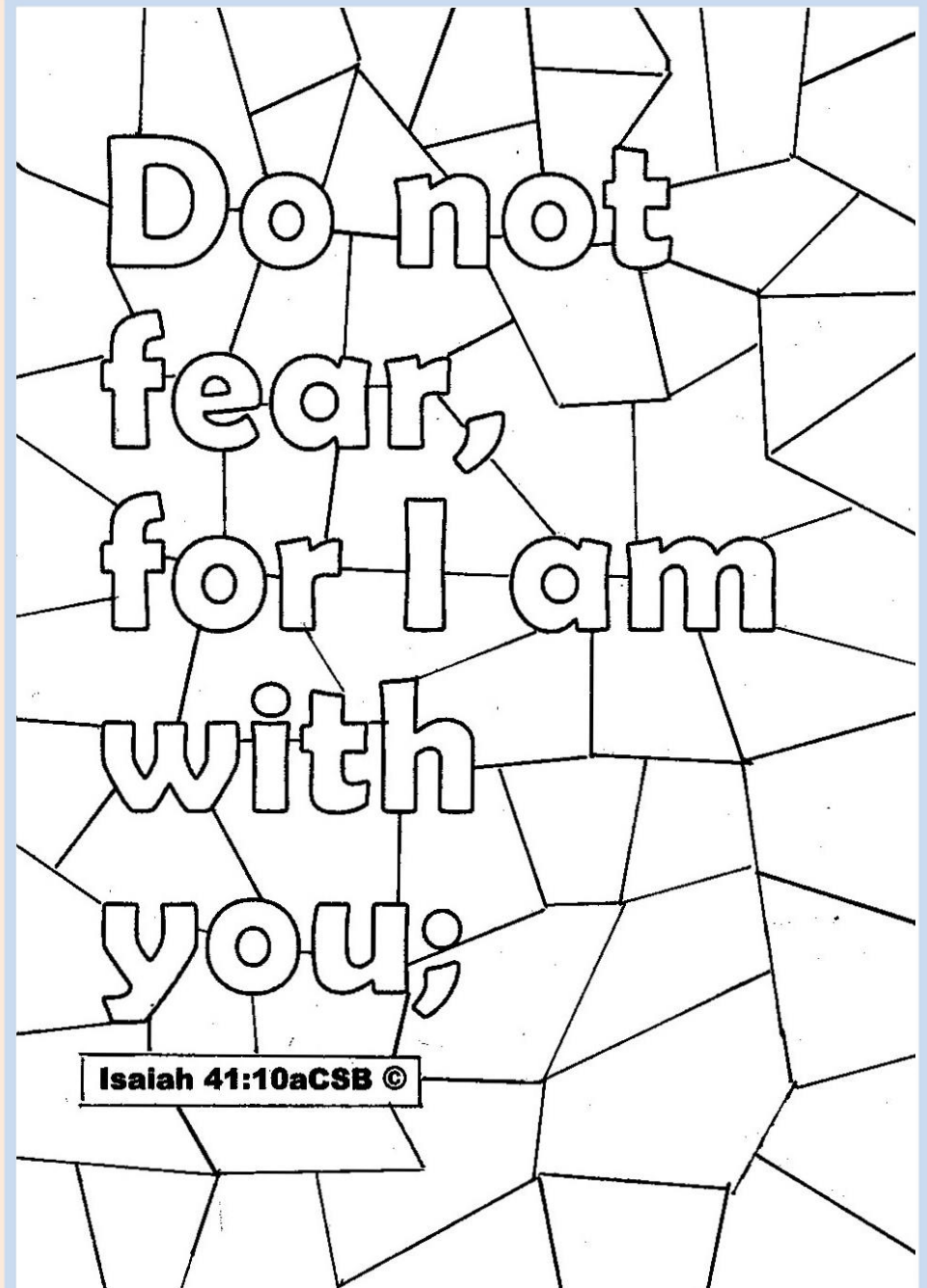

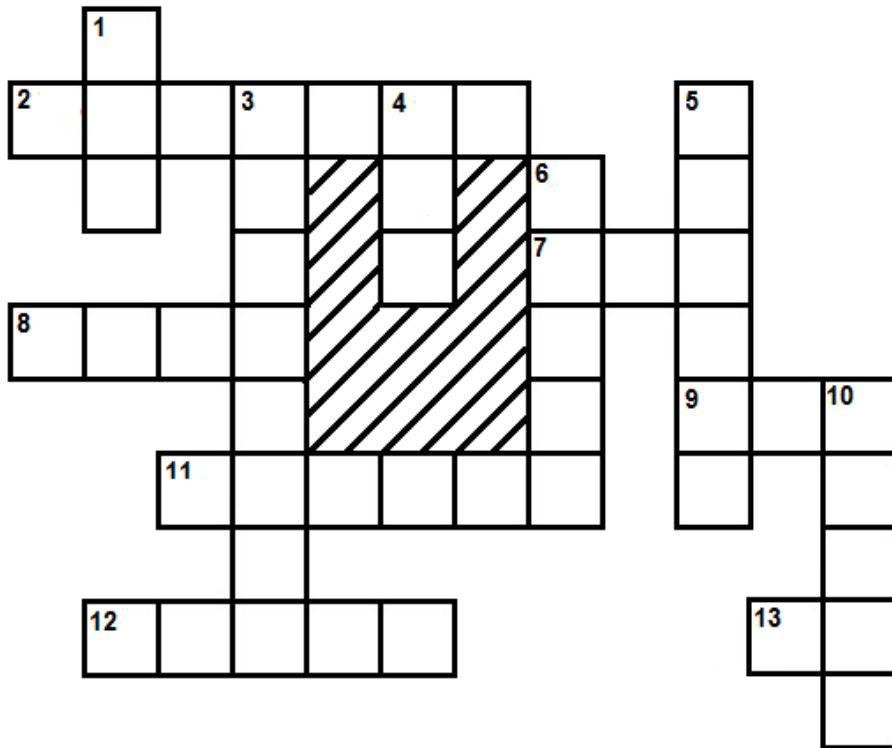

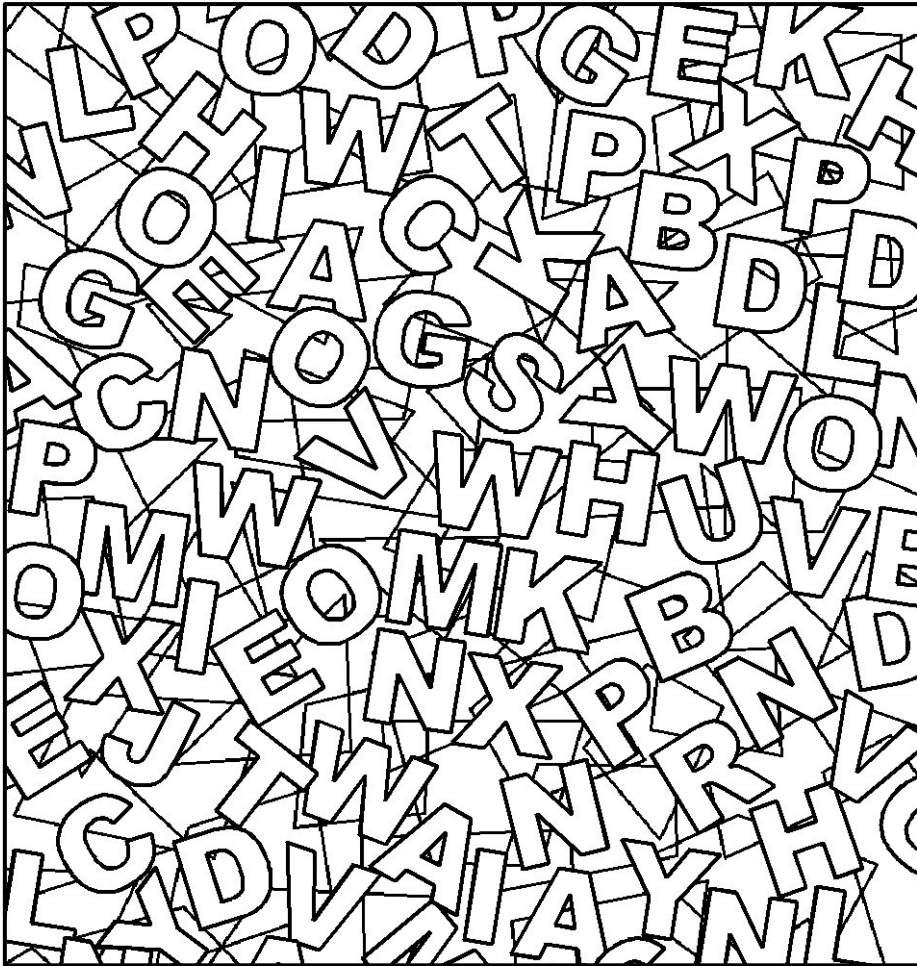
