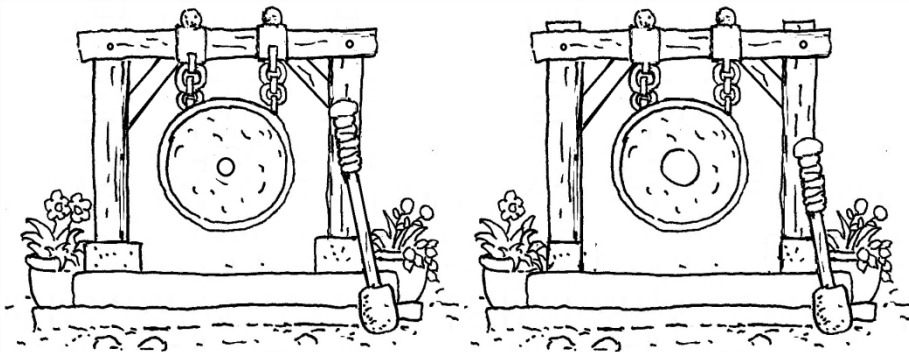


The Way of Love

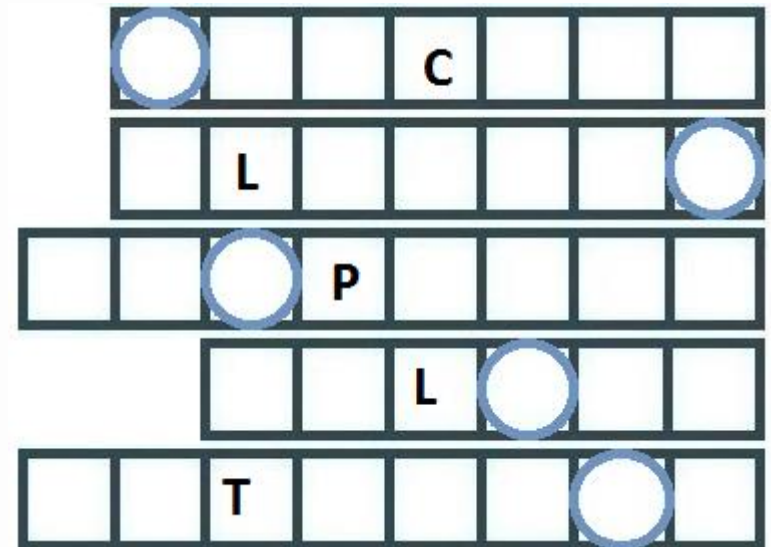


Let's talk about it. If everything you did was worthy of God, would people be happy with what you do? Would God be pleased with it?
