1 Samuel 1:10-17, Abridged

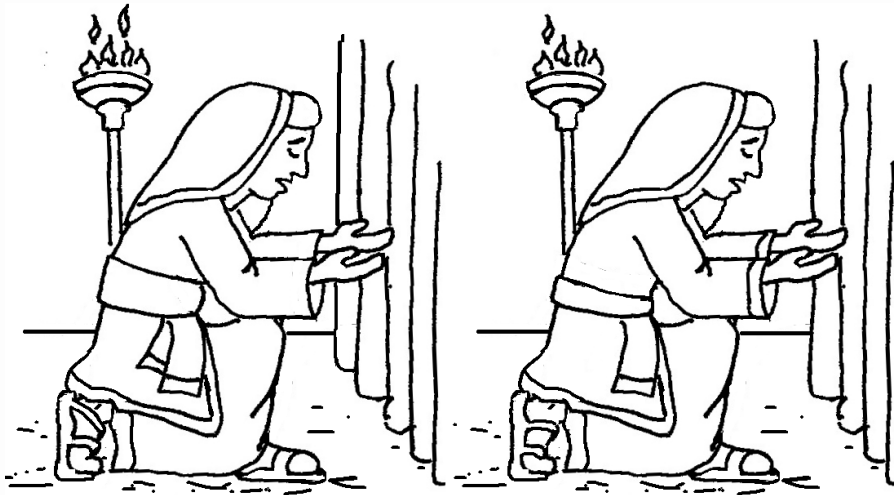
Hannah was so sad that she cried the whole time she was praying to the Lord. She made a special promise to God and said, "Lord All-Powerful, you can see how sad I am.

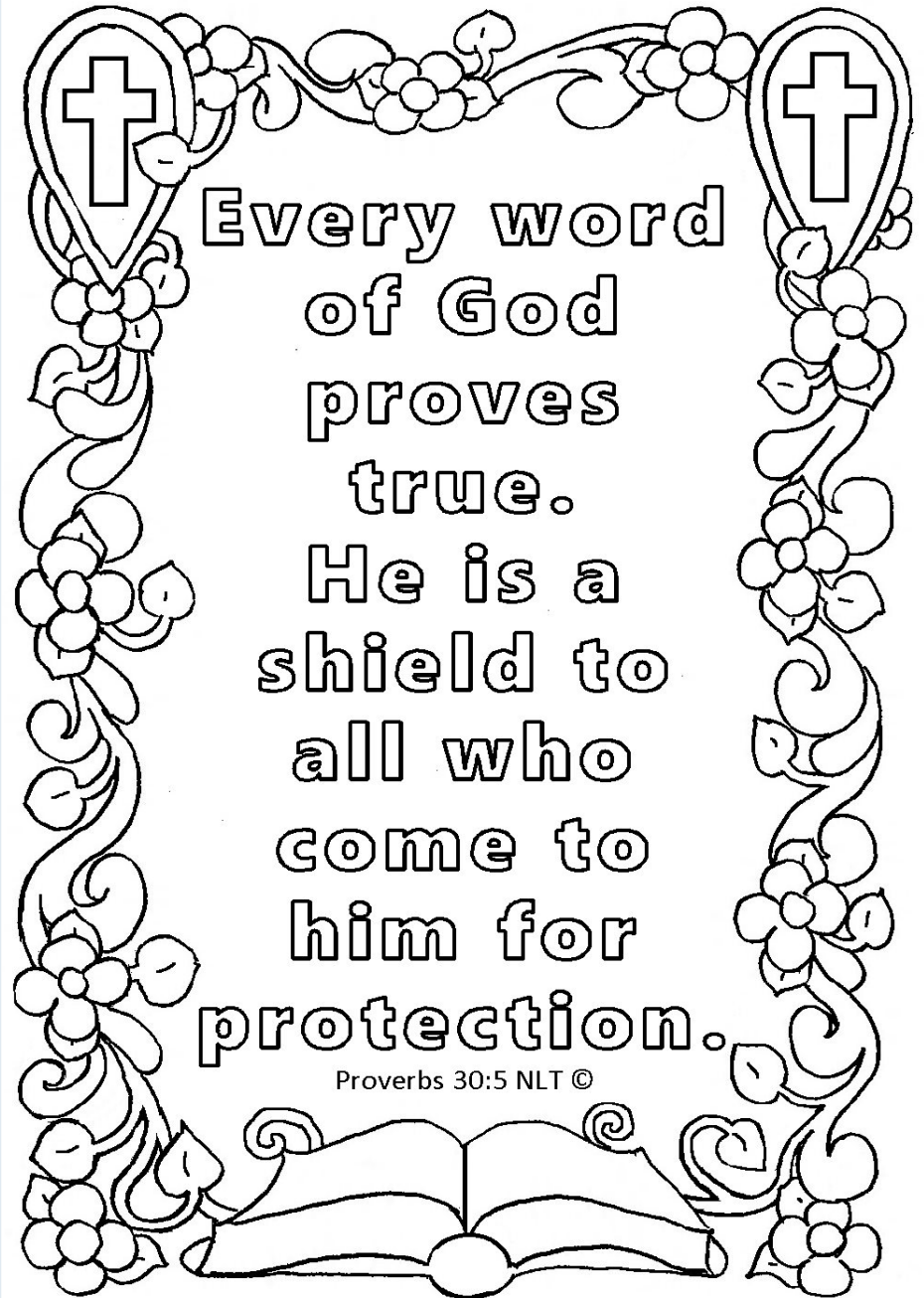

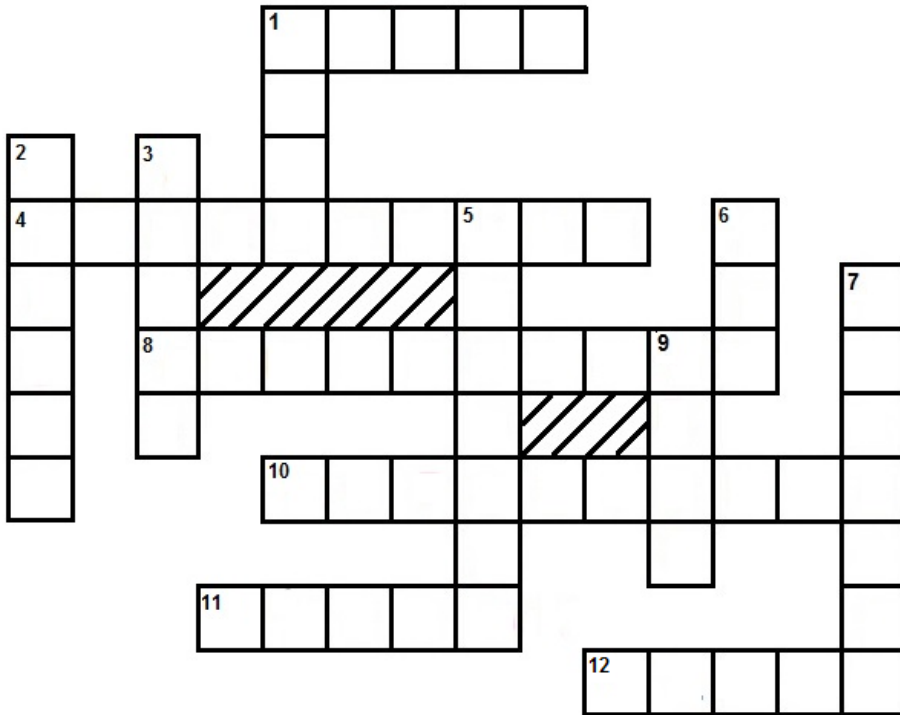


