Thomas said to Jesus, "My Lord and my God!"

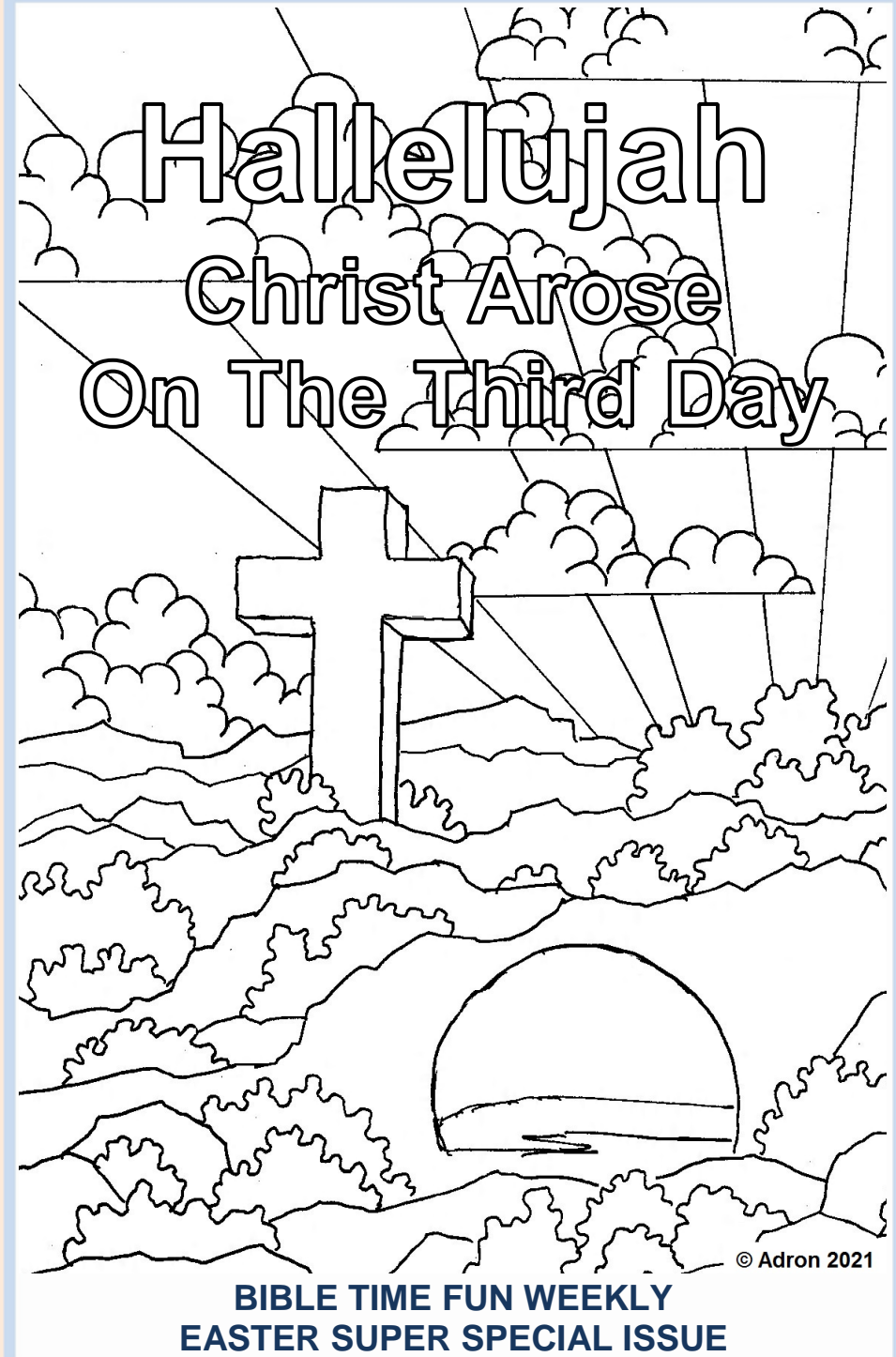
Jesus said to him, "You believe because you see me. Great blessings belong to the people who believe without seeing me!"



Six things are different in the two pictures. Find and circle them.

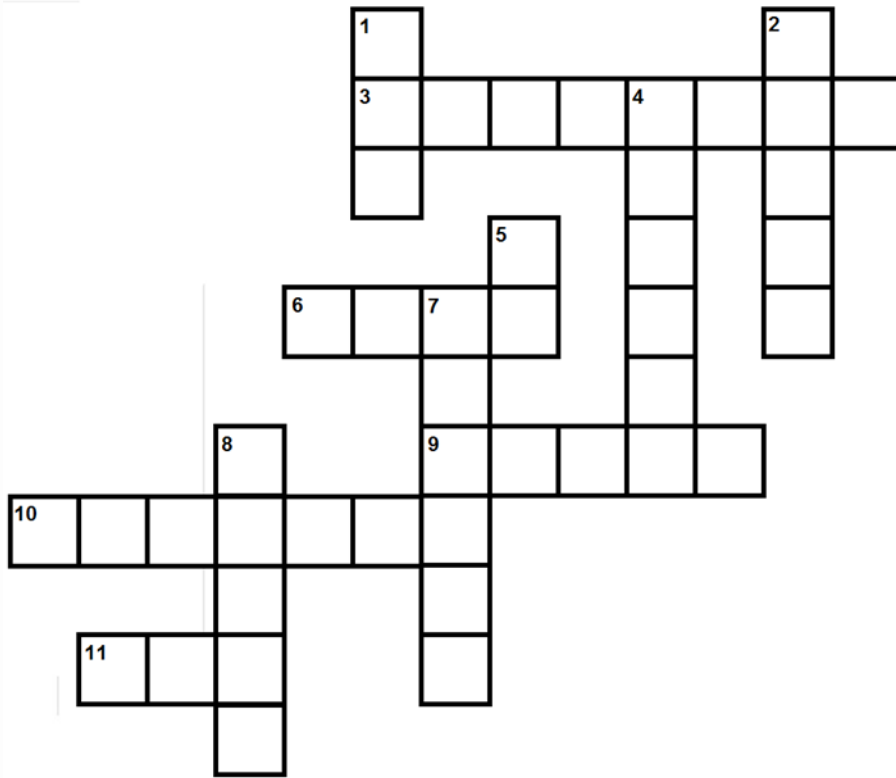
