

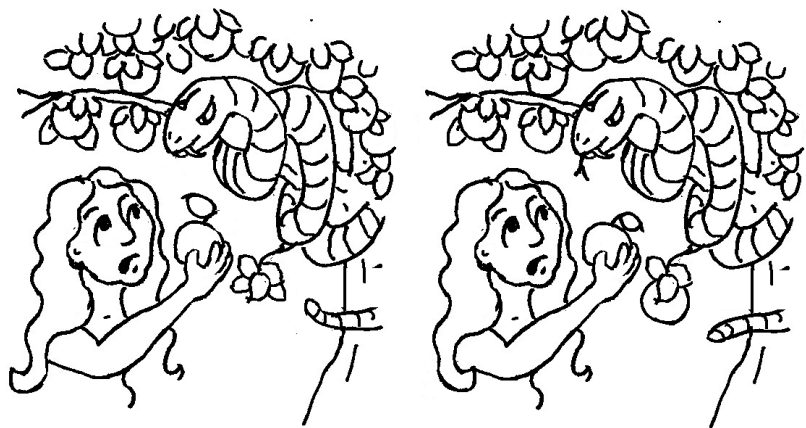
## THE SNAKE TRICKS EVE
