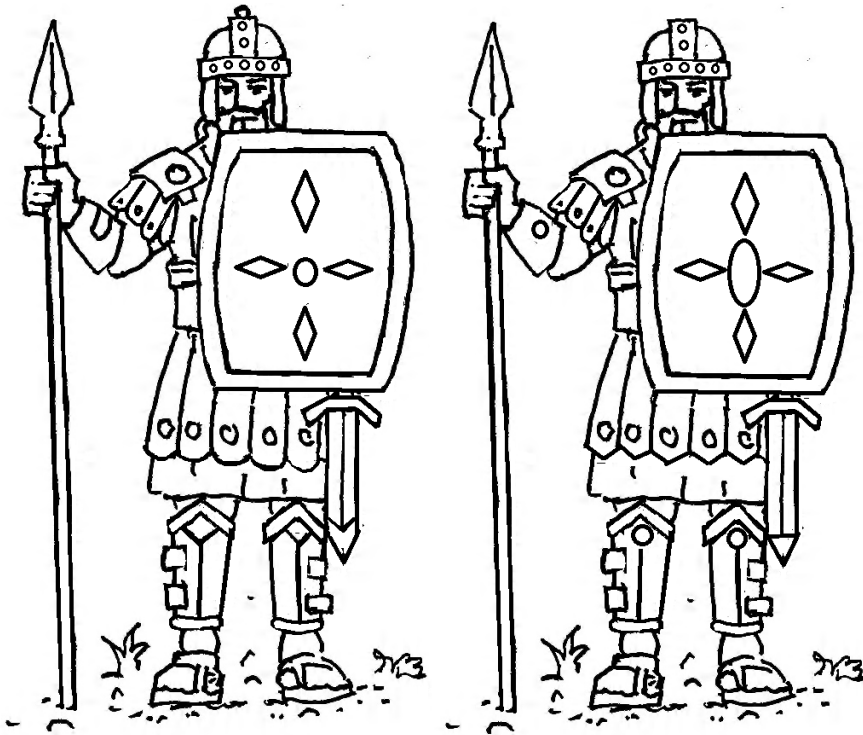


David's answer to Goliath

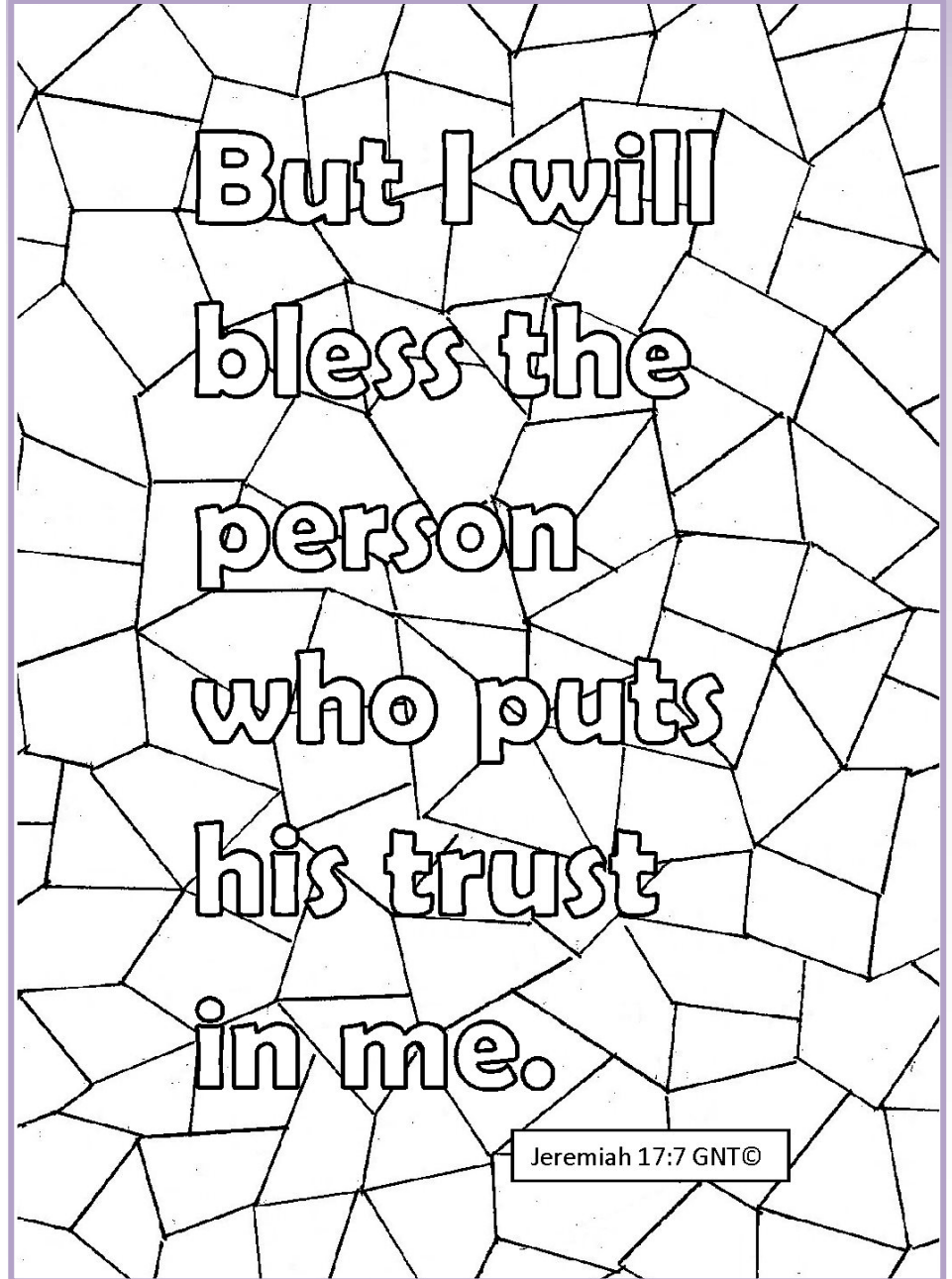

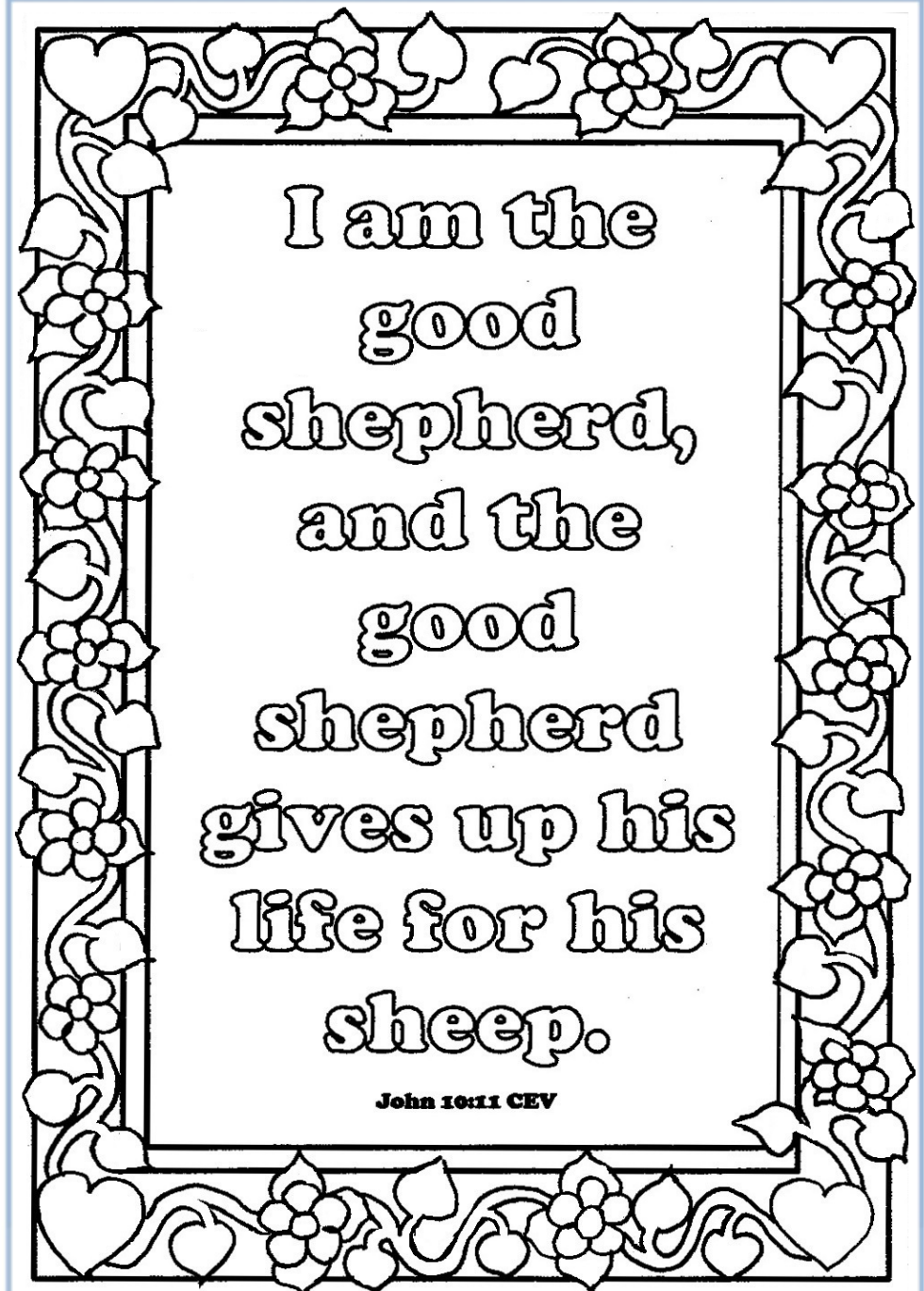

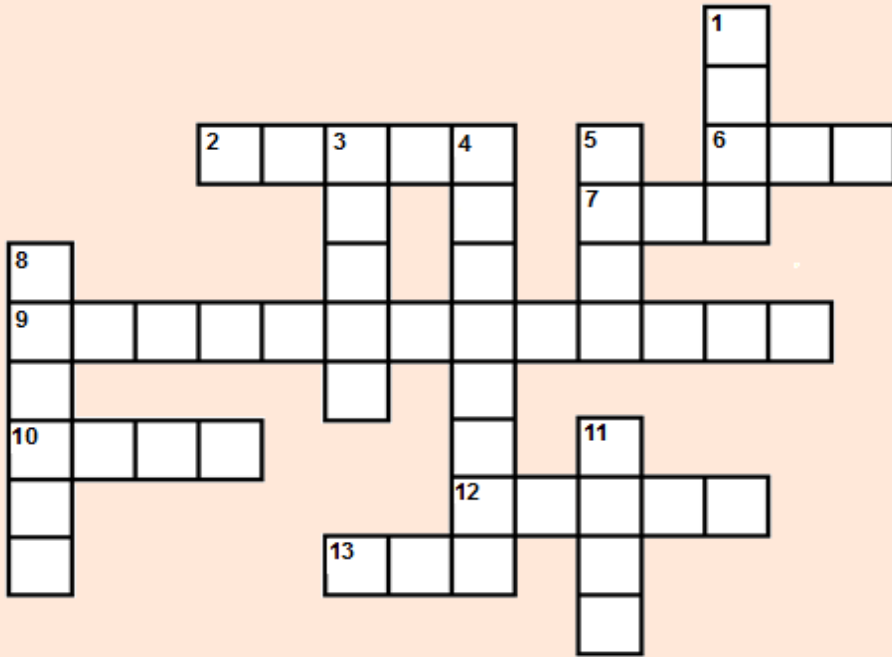
