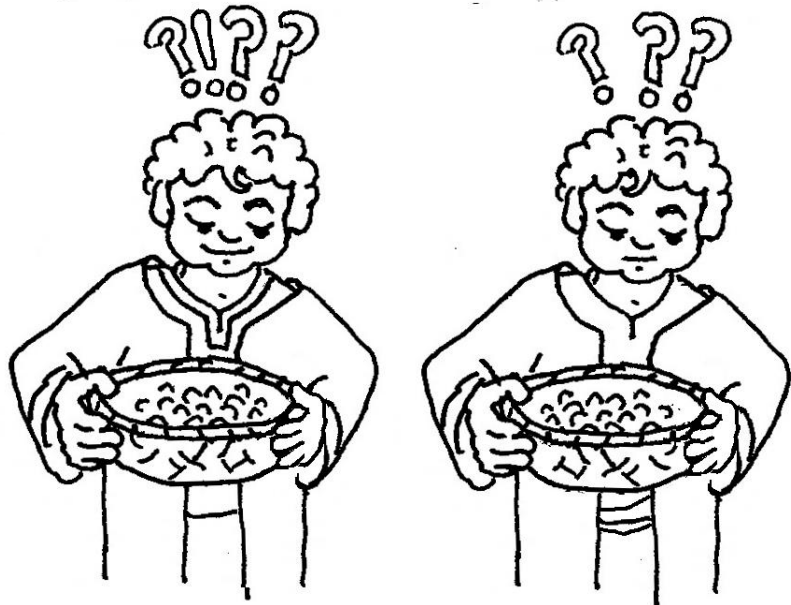


God Feeds the People in the Desert.
