PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH ON SUNDAY

Pray that God shows them they can be free from darkness. “He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son,” Colossians 1:13 ESV©

Pray for God to be true to His name, “Redeemer.” (*Jehovah Go’el*) Meaning: “*The LORD our redeemer*” “Then all flesh shall know that I am the LORD your Savior, and your Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob.” Isaiah 49:26b ESV©
