Jesus arrived in Bethany and found that Lazarus had already been dead and in the tomb for four days.

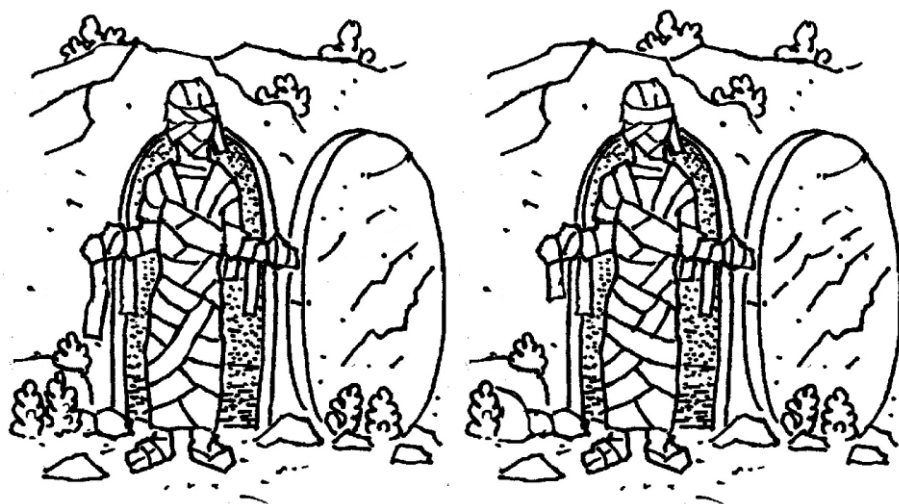
He asked, "Where did you put him?"
