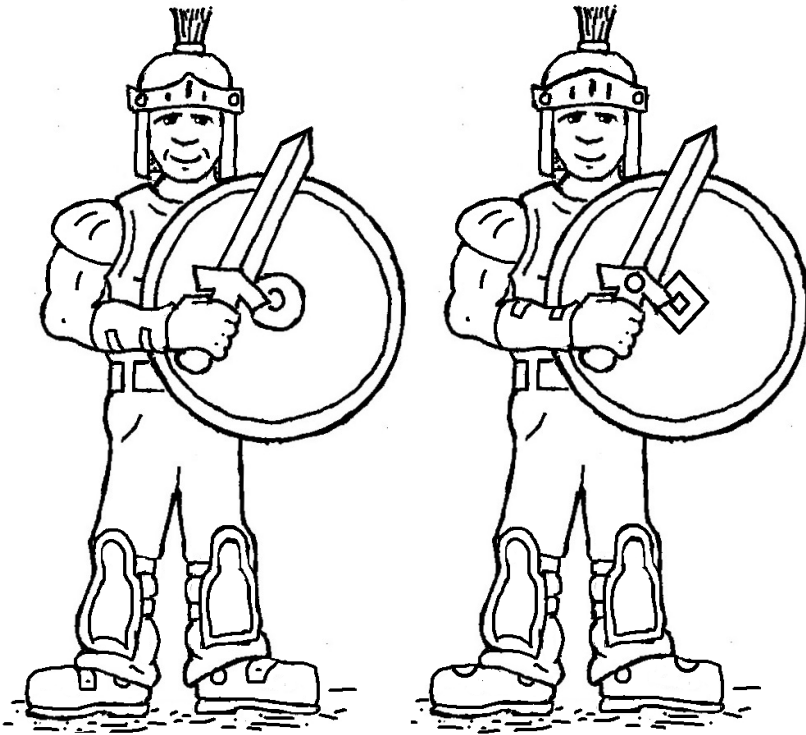


ARMOR OF FAITH
