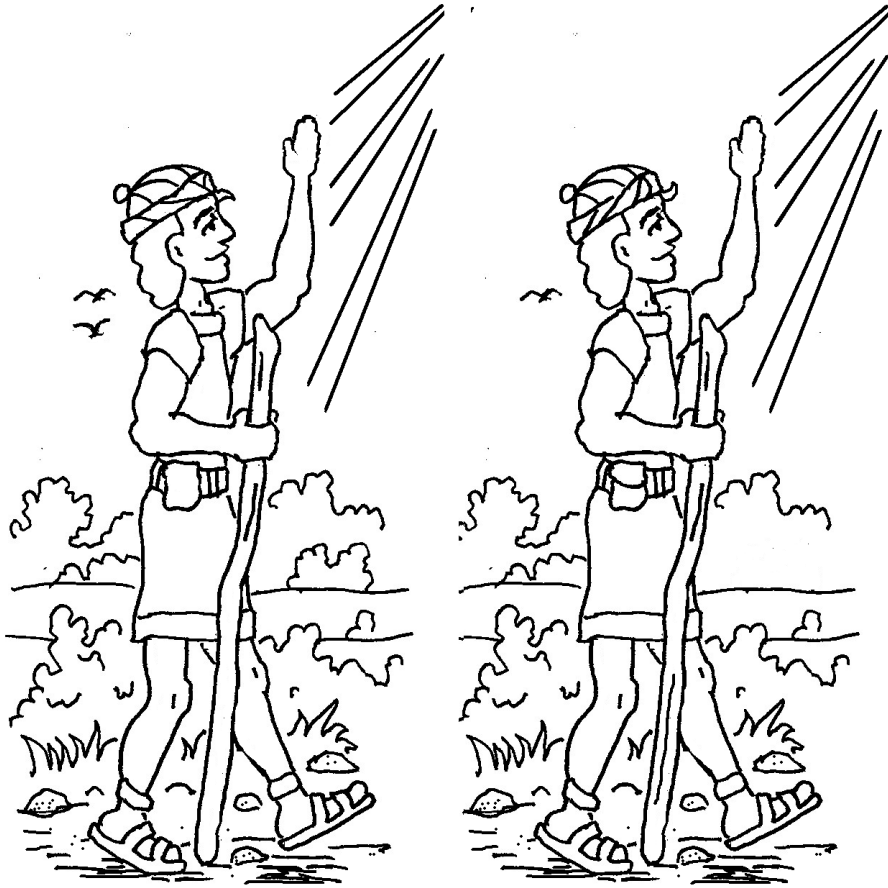


## ENOCH WALKED WITH GOD
