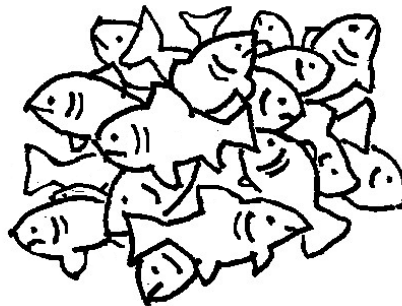
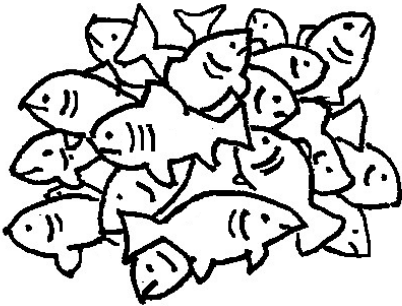


**THE MIRACULOUS CATCH OF FISH**
