Wednesday: Pray we see and take hold of evangelistic opportunities this holiday season.

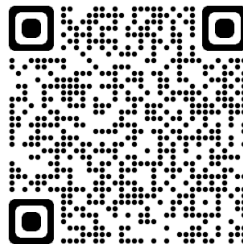
Thursday: Pray our growing zeal to support missionaries and Christian workers stays strong.

Pray the Name of God, “Jehovah Go'el.” It means: *“The LORD our redeemer.”* “Then all flesh shall know that I am the LORD your Savior, and your Redeemer (Jehovah Go'el), the Mighty One of Jacob.” Isaiah 49:26b ESV©

Pray that they admit the truth of their sinfulness. “As it is written: ‘None is righteous, no, not one; no one understands; no one seeks for God. All have turned aside; together they have become worthless; no one does good, not even one.’” Romans 3:10-11 ESV©

Claim the purpose of Christ. “For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.” Luke 19:10 ESV©

Pray God sends someone (or enables you) to share the Gospel. “How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching?” Romans 10:14 ESV©

Pray they cry to God for salvation. “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” Romans 10:13 ESV©
