Thursday: Pray we all share the Gospel daily.

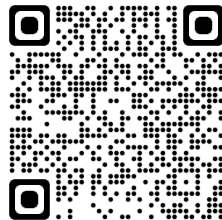
Friday: Pray for those who have broken hearts.
