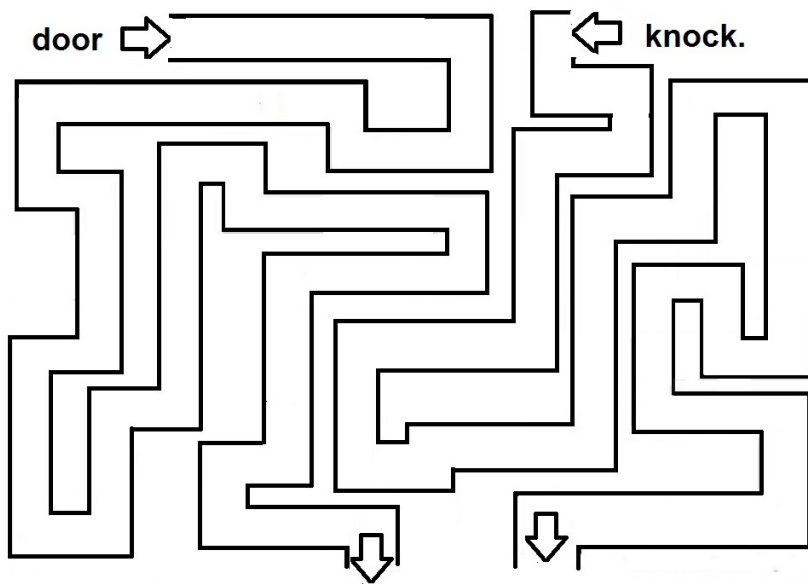

Circle the six differences between the two sandals.

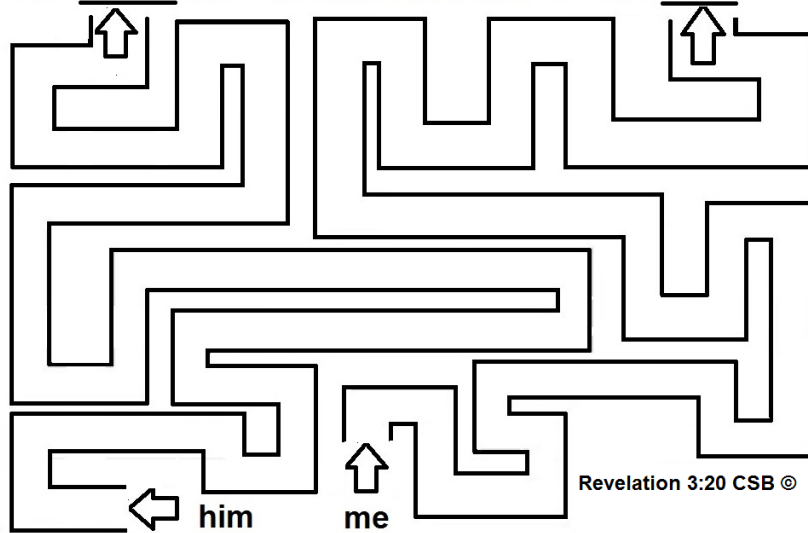
