Wednesday: Pray we have great zeal for Christ.

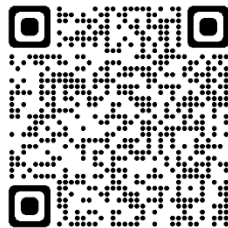
Thursday: Pray for God to provide resources for our growth.

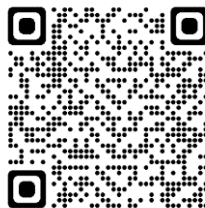
