Wednesday: Pray for young wives and moms.

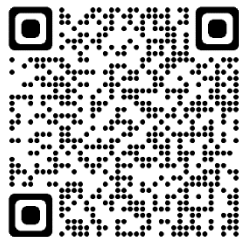
Thursday: Pray our college students reconnect to Christian clubs when they return to school.
