Wednesday: Pray for unity, humility, and love to grow.

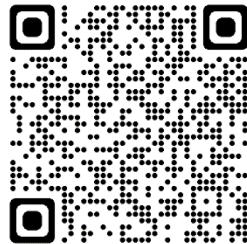
Thursday: Pray we joyfully use our gifts to serve.
