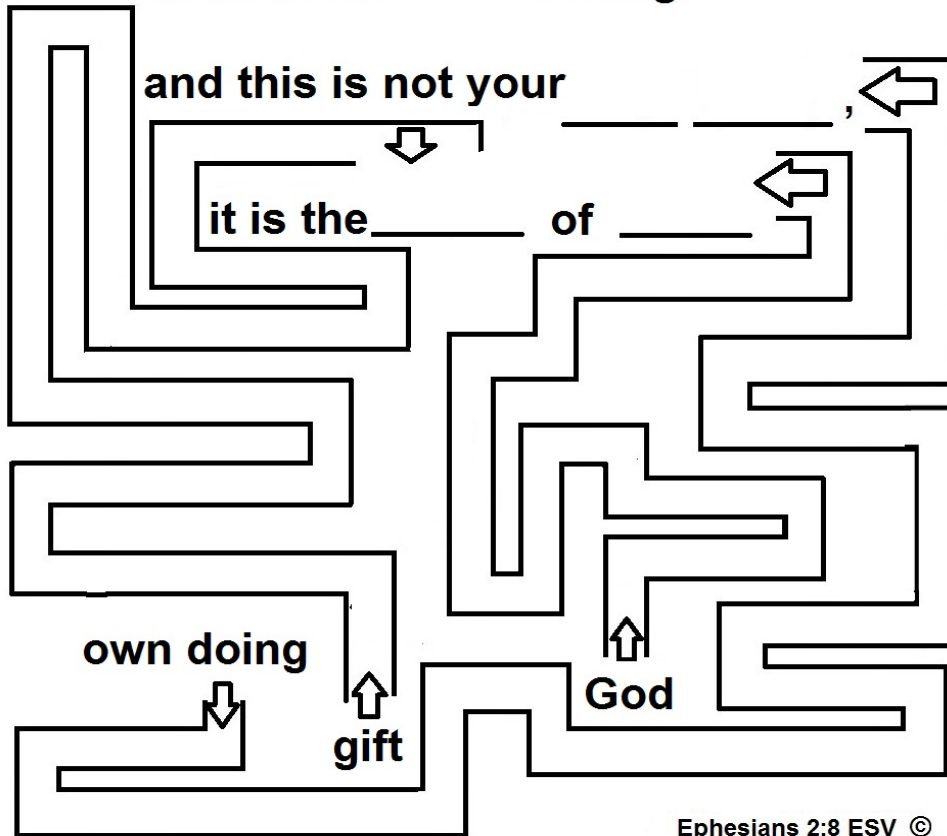
Circle the six differences between the pictures.
