Friday: Pray that our eyes stay on God and don't drift.

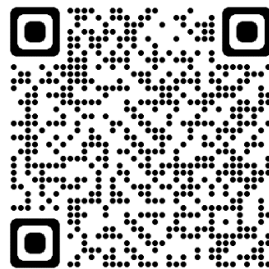
Saturday: Pray for gospel conversations with the lost.
