Wednesday: Pray for ministry leaders, and deacons to not grow weary but to continue to serve well.

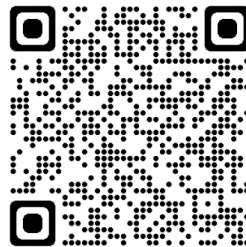
Thursday: Pray that we will have a deep longing for the return of the Lord.
