Wednesday: Pray for men’s ministry and fellowship.

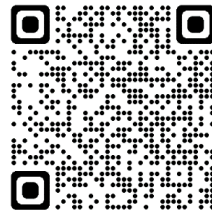
Thursday: Pray we grow in Biblical prayer.

Pray they encounter Jesus and confess him as Lord. “And every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.” Philippians 2:11 ESV©
