Wednesday: Pray for our school aged children, youth and collegiates to resist the world’s allurements.

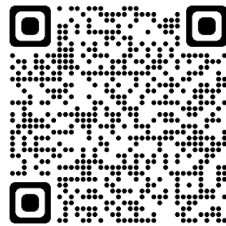
Thursday: Pray our leaders remain above reproach.
