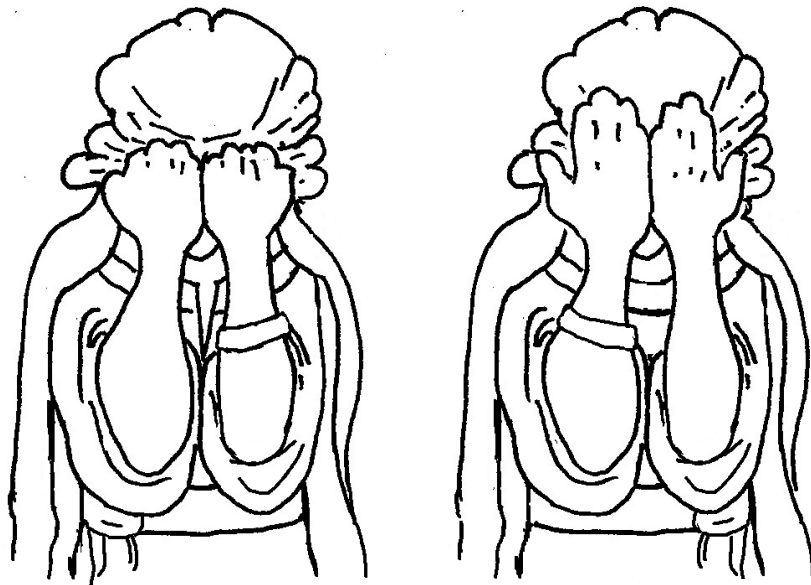


ELIJAH AND THE VOICE OF THE LORD. 1 Kings 19:11-13 HCSB©

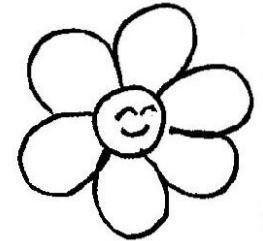


Circle the four differences between the two pictures of Elijah.
