**Wednesday:** Pray our fellowship groups grow spiritually and reflect the first-century church culture.

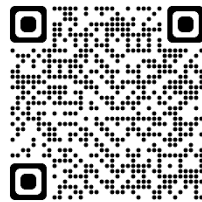
**Thursday:** Pray for our core group of prayer warriors to grow in numbers.
