Thursday: Pray for anyone who needs healing.

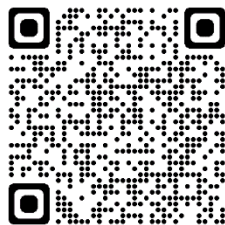
Friday: Pray that we boldly share our testimony.

Pray that they are “sanctified” (set apart by God) for salvation. “According to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in the sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience to Jesus Christ and for sprinkling with his blood:” 1 Peter 1:2 ESV©

Declare before God, why it is his desire they must become saved. “Set forth your case, says the Lord; bring your proofs, says the King of Jacob.” Isaiah 41:21 ESV©

Pray that they stop trusting in their efforts but accept God’s gift. “For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.” Ephesians 2:8-9 ESV©

Pray that the purpose of Christ will be fulfilled. “I have not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance.” Luke 5:32 ESV©

Pray with another and claim the promise of united prayer. “Again I say to you, if two of you agree on earth about anything they ask, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. Matthew 18:19 ESV©
