Wednesday: Pray our various ministry teams grow.

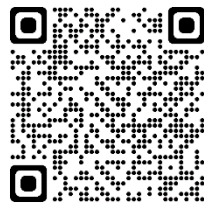
Thursday: Pray we have hearts full of love for Jesus.
