

Jesus Stops the Stormy Sea.

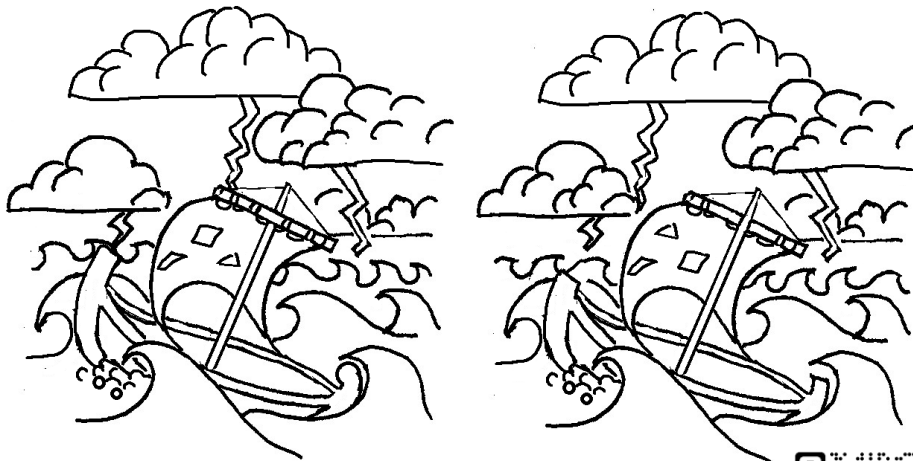
Mark 4:35-41 ERV©
