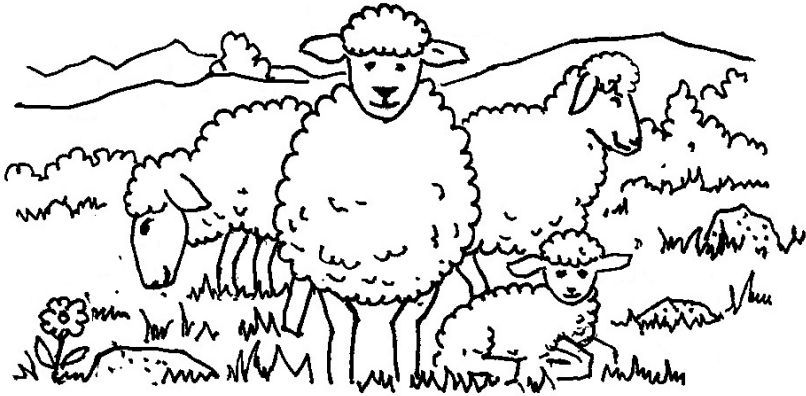
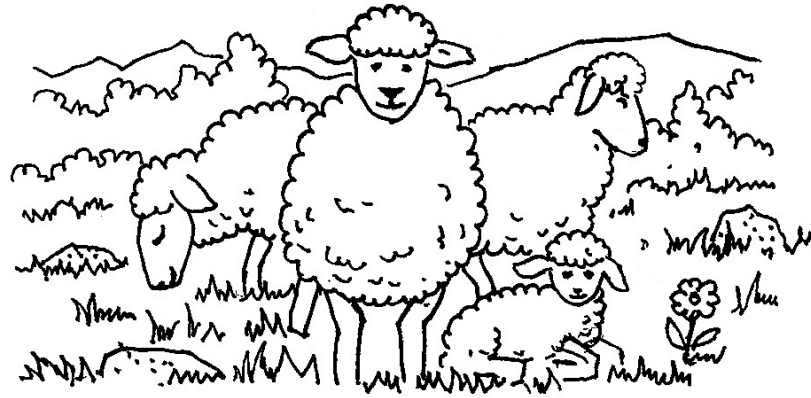

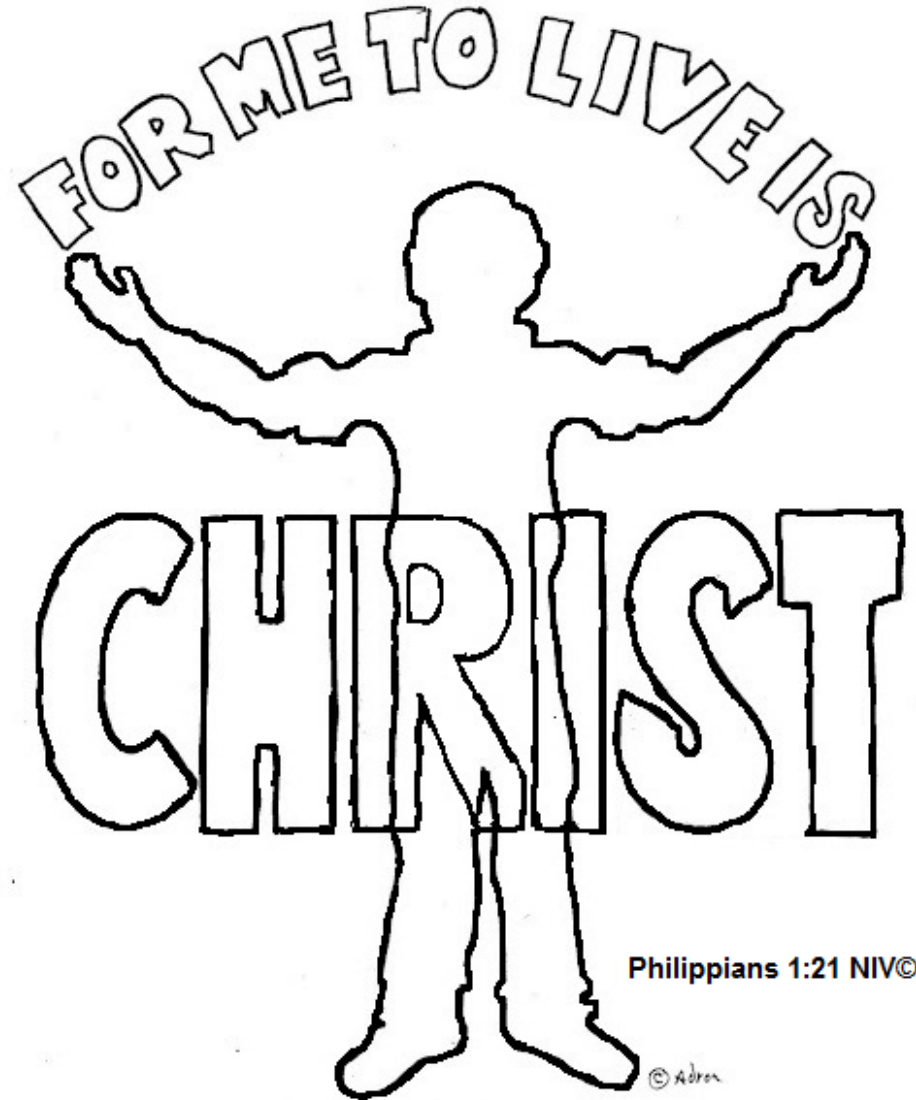


Circle the six differences between the two pictures.
