We're seeking an **Pastoral Intern of Family Discipleship** to lead, develop, and disciple children, youth, and their families under the supervision of the Senior Pastor. This role focuses primarily on discipling those who have not yet attained adult status (children and youth), while partnering with parents and the broader congregation to support their responsibility in raising children in the faith.
