Position Summary

This role exists to help middle and high school students meet Jesus, grow as disciples, and feel genuinely known in the church. You will lead a simple, sustainable student ministry rhythm, equip a team of adult volunteers, and partner with parents as the primary disciplers in the home. We have a generous ministry budget allocated to fund a substantial ministry effort.

What You Will Do

- Lead students toward Christ-centered discipleship by prioritizing relational ministry.
- Teach Scripture in a way that is faithful, accessible, and compelling for grades 6–12.
- Plan and lead a consistent weekly rhythm (youth gathering and/or small groups).
- Recruit, screen, and develop a healthy team of adult volunteers (training, scheduling, and care).
- Partner with parents through clear communication and practical equipping.
- Plan a few key ministry moments each year (retreat/camp, service or outreach, seasonal events) that reinforce discipleship.
- Coordinate calendars, budget, and basic ministry administration in alignment with church leadership.
- Ensure youth environments are safe and compliant with the church's child protection policies (including background checks and appropriate safeguards).

Role Scope (Director)

This position is a staff ministry leadership role, not an elder role. The Director works under the oversight of the Lead Pastor and Elder Team and leads student ministry with a high degree of trust, humility, and accountability.

What We Are Looking For

- A clear love for Jesus, a life consistent with the gospel, and a desire to help students follow Him.
- A sense of calling to student ministry and the ability to teach the Bible effectively.
- Relational warmth with students and strong communication with parents and volunteers.
- Dependable follow-through and the ability to lead a volunteer team with clarity and care.
- Willingness to complete and maintain required screening and background checks consistent with church policy.
- High character and integrity consistent with the biblical expectations for ministry leaders (e.g., 1 Timothy 3; Titus 1).
